RCI HAS SUBMITTED A DEFENCE

The members of the RCI Action Group Committee met recently at the offices of the lawyers, Messrs. Edwin Coe LLP to review the Defence received from the lawyers representing RCI Europe.

RCI has admitted that timeshares lodged within the exchange scheme were rented out both to members of the scheme and to non-members. However RCI claims that this was done to balance supply and demand so that as many members as possible could get their desired exchanges.

We submit that this was in breach of their membership agreement with our members.

They also claim that only 1 in 15,000 members did not get their requested exchanges.

We know that this is not the case, our own members having had continuous refusals for exchanges year after year.
